Railroad & Ferry Depot Museum
1920 Paradise Drive, Tiburon
Tiburon has a rich railroad and maritime history, which is captured in this Museum. The lovely restored gray building, which is on the National Register of Historic Places, captures the past in two museums. On the ground floor, a detailed operating HO-scale train model of Tiburon c.1910. Upstairs is where the stationmaster's family lived from 1913 to 1940.



Old St. Hilary

Old St. Hilary's
201 Esperanza Street, Tiburon
This redwood mission was built in 1888 to serve the railroad families and dairy workers. In the midst of a rare wildflower preserve and vast open space, with spectacular views of the Golden Gate and San Francisco Bay, this iconic landmark is often rented for weddings and memorial services. It also provides fine acoustics for frequent Landmarks concerts.



China Cabin

China Cabin
52 Beach Road, Belvedere
The gilded Victorian drawing room was salvaged from the deck of the transpacific steamer *SS CHINA* before it was scrapped in the Tiburon Cove in 1886. Beautifully restored in the 1980's, it has been designated a National Maritime Monument. Suitable for smaller weddings, receptions or corporate meetings. Located on the water surrounded by decks with beautiful views of the San Francisco Bay.



Art & Garden
Center

Art & Garden Center
841 Tiburon Boulevard, Tiburon
The restored 1870's bunkhouse-farmhouse on an acre of terraced gardens has two galleries for exhibits and receptions. The country garden pathways connect the lawn and central brick terrace to the many patios overlooking the Richardson Bay, the Sausalito hills and Mt. Tamalpais. This site makes a lovely setting for weddings, memorial services, luncheons, dinners & meetings.


History Collections


About the Landmarks!
