## The Saving of Richardson Bay

- This 50 minute video created in 2007 retells through interviews, archival photographs and vintage film the story of this pivotal event in Tiburon Peninsula history, and one of the earliest environmental preservation efforts in Marin County.
- The dramatic community effort which blocked a massive, 2000-home development called *Reeds Port* proposed for the tidelots of Richardson Bay.
- The history, rescue, transport and conservation of the lovely *Lyford House*.
- The story of Rose Verrall, Tiburon’s “Goat Lady”, who donated her valuable land which now serves as the site for the *Lyford House* and the *Richardson Bay Audubon Center*.
